1. **Adventure at the Rieselfelder + Ra.Baba Bioland Garden**

Discover what lives in the nearby Rieselfelder—meadows, forests, ponds. Catch frogs, snakes, and other pond animals with a net. On Friday, we visit Haus Coerde and learn in the “Ra.Baba” organic garden where the veggies and herbs grow that we can eat.

2. **Painting Fun in the Artist’s Studio**
